2. To keep a continuous watch and vigil over ragging so as to prevent its occurrence and recurrence.
3. To promptly and stringently deal with the incidents of ragging brought to our notice.
4. Decided to celebrate Anti-ragging week from 12-18<sup>th</sup> Aug 2024

### **Discussions and Resolutions:**

#### **1. Awareness about Dehumanizing Effects of Ragging:**

- The committee emphasized the importance of educating students about the harmful psychological and physical impacts of ragging.
- Contacts details of committee members will be displayed in prominent areas across the campus.

#### **2. Continuous Watch and Vigil:**

- To prevent incidents of ragging, it was decided to establish a dedicated "Anti-Ragging Task Force" comprising faculty, staff, and student representatives.
- CCTV cameras will be installed in sensitive areas, to enhance surveillance.

#### **3. Prompt and Stringent Action against Ragging:**

- The committee resolved to adopt a zero-tolerance policy toward ragging, with strict disciplinary actions against offenders.
- A standard operating procedure (SOP) will be developed for investigating and addressing ragging complaints.

### **Conclusion:**

The committee reaffirmed its commitment to maintaining a safe and inclusive environment on campus. The next review meeting is scheduled for Nov 2024.

## Anti-Ragging Meeting

A meeting of the Anti-Ragging Committee was held on Nov 25th at 2.00 pm in the Principal's office under the chairmanship of Dr Anupam Singh, head of Institute and committee member. The agenda for the meeting was as follows:

1. To review the case of ragging if any.
2. To guide BAMS 1<sup>st</sup> proff students about anti-ragging SOP.
3. Any other relevant subject at the time of meeting.

### **Discussions and Resolutions:**

#### **1. Review of Ragging Cases:**

- The committee reviewed the records and found no reported incidents of ragging since the last meeting.
- Members reiterated the importance of maintaining vigilance and ensuring that any incidents, if they occur, are promptly reported and addressed.

#### **2. Guidance for BAMS 1st-Year Students on Anti-Ragging SOP:**

- It was resolved to conduct an orientation session specifically for BAMS 1st-year students to familiarize them with the anti-ragging SOP.
- The administration will ensure that all first-year students are aware of their rights and the channels available to report any issues.
- The session will include information on:
  - Definition and examples of ragging.
  - Reporting mechanisms and contact points for complaints.
  - Disciplinary actions for offenders under institutional and legal frameworks.
- Dr Priyanka Singh was assigned to prepare the presentation for the session.

#### **3. Any Other Relevant Subject:**

- **Monitoring Measures:** It was decided to strengthen monitoring efforts during peak hours in hostels and common areas by increasing internal discipline committee rounds.
- **Feedback Mechanism:** Members agreed to introduce a periodic anonymous feedback system for students to share concerns or suggestions regarding the anti-ragging policy.

### **Conclusion:**

The committee expressed satisfaction with the current measures in place but emphasized the need for constant vigilance.
