The Institutional Innovation Committee was formed with an aim to foster creativity and progress within the institution, enhancing the innovations related to teaching and research practices.

Over the past reporting period, the following key initiatives were taken:

1. Collaborative discussions by the committee members to work on innovative projects.
2. Updated the students and faculty about EDC meeting and role/scope of research in Ayurveda
3. SPARK -03 (2024-2025) programme under CCRAS, New Delhi in order to promote interest and aptitude for research in Ayurveda by undergraduate students.
4. Organised an internal 'Idea heckathon' for the students of BAMS to submit their innovative ideas based on Heckathon themes

STEPS TAKEN

1. Members of the committee actively participated in the discussions to create and promote awareness among students for effective implementation of IIC activities in the campus for faculty as well as students.
2. SPARK-03 brochure was shared through their official whatsapp message group. Student members of the committee guided the undergraduate students to participate enthusiastically in the program. 2 students were registered and proposed their research proposal to the CCRAS through SPARK project.
3. Internal idea hackathon was decided to organise in the campus. For this, it was decided to encourage the students to submit their ideas related to hackathon themes. Ideas must focus on technology as its core and aim to solve challenges related to digital tools for ayurvedic practices, bio-instruments for diagnosis and treatment in Ayurveda etc. depend upon hackathon themes.

During this, seven ideas were submitted during the internal idea hackathon. Among them, only 3 ideas were selected for Navpravarthan Idea Heckathon 2024.

CHALLENGES AND FUTURE GOALS

Challenges faced include **limited resources** for innovation and **resistance to change** from some departments. To overcome these, the committee has emphasized on gradual implementation Future goals focus on **expanding the innovative projects** and **increasing external partnerships**.
